

## PRE-LICENSURE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS 2023-2024

**Application Criteria** Applications are accepted every fall and spring semester.

1. Completion of 30 semester credits.
2. A minimum total cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
3. Completion of **Core Pre-requisites** with a minimum C grade.

◦ *International students from non-English speaking countries must meet the School of Nursing English Proficiency Requirement for application eligibility.*
