



Admission Requirements for the MS in Exercise Physiology

Applications for admission to the MS in Exercise Physiology is competitive and all required application materials must be received by February 1st for a Fall start date. Students applying to the program should have or be eligible to complete a bachelor degree by August of the application year. Candidates should have a major in athletic training, exercise science, exercise & sport science, kinesiology, or closely related field. Minimum core coursework for our MS in Exercise Physiology program includes minimum course equivalents in basic statistics, physiology of exercise (undergraduate exercise physiology), and a course in nutrition.

GPA: our program does not have a specified minimum GPA, however a cumulative GPA of 3.0 is typically necessary to compete for a spot.

GRE: We do not require the GRE.
