Application Instructions and Admission Information

Please read all instructions carefully.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

1. Each applicant must submit a properly completed application for admission to the School of Nursing office, WH 360 by the designated deadline.
2. Each applicant is responsible for including all the required information at the time the application is submitted or the application will not be given consideration for admission.
3. The required information includes the most recent Minnesota State University, Mankato transcript (may be unofficial) and/or transfer audit/transfer course conversion form for any transfer credits.
4. Transfer students:
 - a. Apply to Minnesota State University, Mankato before you apply to the School of Nursing.
 - b. Request official transcripts from all colleges or universities you have attended and have them sent to MSU Office of Admissions, 122 Taylor Center. (Please note that the transfer evaluation process may take two to three weeks to complete.) You will receive a transfer conversion form when the process is complete. Attach your transfer conversion form to your nursing application prior to submitting application.
5. On the transcripts or transfer course conversion form, please highlight the courses that are equivalent in MSU's prenursing and foundational courses.
6. The applicant is responsible for being informed about the School of Nursing's specific prenursing and foundational course requirements. These requirements are listed in the Minnesota State Mankato Undergraduate Bulletin and the School of Nursing Facts in Brief at: <http://www.mnsu.edu/nursing>.
7. **All applicants are required to make an office appointment with the Prenursing Advisor/Student Relations Coordinator (507-389-6022) in the School of Nursing when submitting this application.** Transfer students may make a telephone appointment.
