Application Criteria Applications accepted every fall and spring semester.

1. A minimum total cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
2. Completion of Core Pre-requisites with a minimum C grade.

International students from non-English speaking countries must meet the School of Nursing English Language Proficiency Requirement for application eligibility.
