Application for admission to the Pre-Licensure Program is a separate process, and in addition to university admission. Admission is competitive; meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee acceptance. Application periods occur twice per year. Deadlines for application are the fourth Friday of fall and spring semester.

### **Application Criteria**

- 1. A minimum total cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 2. Completion of Core Pre-requisites with a minimum C.

- Group Interview Score (25%)

#### Admission

Full admission requires students to fulfill the following requirements prior to Pre-Licensure Program start date:

- Certified as a nursing assistant, and listed as active on a Nursing Assistant Registry in the United States.
- Completion of Support Pre-requisites with a minimum C grade.
- Approval to work with patients without supervision from the Minnesota Department of Human Services Background check.
