Application for admission to the Pre-Licensure Program is a separate process, in addition to university admission. Applicants are responsible for being informed of the application & admission requirements and the pre-nursing policies found in the Academic Catalog and Pre-Nursing Student Handbook.

Application Criteria

- 1. Completion of 30 semester credits.
- 2. A minimum total cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- 3. Completion of Core pre-reqs with a minimum C grade.

English Language Proficiency Requirement

International applicants from non-English speaking countries must demonstrate one of the minimum English proficiency requirements:

- TOEFL iBT minimum score of 84 with a minimum speaking score of 26.
- TOEFL PBT minimum score of 560.
- IELTS overall score of 6.5 with a minimum 6.0 on all modules.

Application Procedures

Applicants must submit the application forms with required materials, complete the TEAS exam, and participate in a group interview. Late applications will not be reviewed.

Application Forms & Documents

Applicants are responsible for including all required information on the application forms (2 pages) and submit materials to the School of Nursing Office by 12:00pm on the deadline: Friday, February 2, 2024.

Application materials may be mailed, but must be received by the deadline.

Nursing advisors will review submitted materials and may contact students with questions.

TEAS Exam

The ATI TEAS is a 209-minute computerized exam administered on campus by the MNSU University Testing Center.

TEAS Test Dates

Friday, January 19, 2024: 12:00pm
 Saturday, January 20, 2024: 10:00am
 Friday, January 26, 2024: 12:00pm

The TEAS Exam must be completed by the application deadline.

TEAS Score

Students testing through the University Testing Center do not need to submit a score report. TEAS scores will be obtained electronically by the School of Nursing.

Students testing at an alternate site must request an official TEAS transcript to be sent to MNSU. These transcripts must be received by the deadline.

TEAS Registration & Payment

TEAS registration opens November 20, 2023.

Applicants are responsible for creating an ATI account, registering for a test date, and paying ATI directly for the cost of the exam (\$97).

Applicants will find testing information, policies, preparation information and registration instructions under the TEAS Exam subsection found on the Pre-Licensure Program Advising site HERE.

Group Interview

All group interviews will take place throughout the week of February 12th. Qualified applicants will receive an email the Monday after the deadline inviting them to sign up for a group interview electronically, along with additional preparatory information. Interviews are expected to last 30 minutes.

Admission Ranking

Each applicant will be rank-ordered using their Core Pre-requisite GPA, the total TEAS score and group interview score.

- Core GPA is 50% of ranking.
- Total TEAS score is 25% of ranking.
- Group interview score is 25% of ranking.

The School of Nursing will admit the top 72 students from the rank-ordered applicant pool.

Admission

Full admission to the Pre-Licensure program requires the completion of the following requirements prior to the program start date:

- Certification as a Nursing Assistant and listed as active on a Nursing Assistant Registry in the United States.
- Successful completion of the Support pre-requisites with a minimum C grade [BIOL 270, FCS 242, PSYC 101, NURS 282, NURS 284, NURS 286]
- Approval to work with patients without supervision from the Minnesota Department of Human Services Background check.

Additional information regarding these requirements will be provided to those admitted.

Pre-Licensure Program

The Pre-Licensure Program is approved by the Minnesota Board of Nursing and accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE). The program is comprised of 59 major credits and leads to a Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in Nursing.

Graduates of the Pre-Licensure Program are prepared to take the National Council Licensure Examination-Registered Nursing (NCLEX-RN). Successfully passing this exam permits the graduate to practice as a registered nurse (R.N.). Graduates with a Bachelor of Science Degree with a major in Nursing will have met the requirements for public health nurse certification and licensure as a school nurse in Minnesota.

Pre-Nursing Appeal

 Applicants who received approval of a Pre-Nursing Appeal must submit a copy of the official approval letter from the Pre-Licensure Program Committee.

English Language Proficiency

 International student applicants from non-English speaking countries must submit a copy of their TOEFL or IELTS scores by the deadline.

Application Deadline

 The application forms, transcript(s), Degree Audit and any additional materials must be submitted to the School of Nursing office (Wissink Hall 360) by 12:00pm on the application deadline: Friday, February 2, 2024.

TEAS Exam

- The TEAS exam must be completed by the application deadline.
- Submit official TEAS transcript if taken at an alternate testing site.

Group Interview
