

The nursing major contains a prescribed curricular plan. The pre-requisites and major classes require 30 specific courses, or 109 credits. In total, a bachelor's degree requires 120 credits, thus nursing majors are left with little time or flexibility to pursue minor or certificate programs. Strategic planning with academic advisors will be necessary, but graduation extension may be a reality.

However, many students today transfer-in credits from other colleges, which can grant nursing students the flexibility to take additional coursework towards a minor or certificate. Nursing majors also pursue these programs as part of the parallel planning process. This allows students to easily pivot to an alternate major that aligns with their minor or certificate coursework.
